



# **Recycling Rate and Utilisation of Paper** for Recycling in Europe
















# **CEPI Utilisation of Paper for Recycling** by Sector in 2012

#### **Paper Recycling in Central Europe**



Paper for recycling is not only recycled in the country where it is produced, therefore some essential features such as ecodesign and ecocollection concepts must be developed at a transnational level to increase the sustainability of the paper loop.

Improper collection systems can drastically reduce the amount of paper being recovered for recycling; and improper design of a graphic or packaging product can create problems in the recycling process, lower the recycled paper quality and worsen the environmental impact.

#### In Central Europe regions paper for recycling is a major resource.

- paper recycling rates are still highly inhomogeneous
- collection systems are different
- Recyclability oriented ecodesign of paper products is not always addressed.












## **EcoPaperLoop** – project structure

- □ Roadmap for new transnational policy strategies in the paper for recycling field.





### **Activity on paper based products Recyclability assessment**



Goal: Create a large database on the recyclability of paper based products in Central Europe

- ☐ New shared method for testing packaging products recyclability was developed
- ☐ Round Robin Test performed in four laboratories
  - PMV (DE), Innovhub (IT), UWH (HU), ICP (SI)
- ☐ Laboratory assessment campaign just launched 160 packaging samples to be assessed 60 graphic products to be assessed by INGEDE Methods / ERPC Scorecard Initial focus on Polish packaging products

## **Ecodesign for recycling:** Criteria for sustainability evaluation



#### Goal:

Enhancing life cycle thinking in paper based products ecodesign, for the improvement of recycling behaviour and sustainability

- Sustainability assessment of recycling oriented ecodesign of paper products (case studies):
  - LCA on graphic products
  - LCA on packaging products









#### Approach for EcoPaperLoop LCA



- Determination of environmental impacts for products and comparison
- Packaging
  - Recyclable
  - Non-recyclable
- Graphic
  - Recyclable on similar quality level
  - Recyclable on lower quality level
  - Recyclable only for packaging
